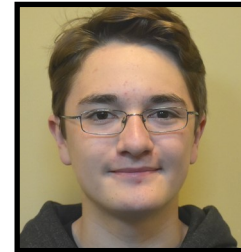
April Cascante, Atina, Ensemble

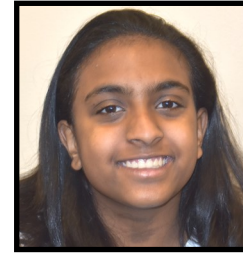
